- Strong visual storytelling and conceptual thinking skills.
- Ability to produce high-quality, innovative designs under tight deadlines.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team environment.
- High level of accuracy and keen eye for detail.
- A portfolio showcasing previous design work is required.
